

Update - May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020

We miss our library patrons and look forward to reopening the libraries! Over the coming weeks, the Pulaski County Library District will slowly and gradually reopen. The exact timeline of our reopening may change, depending on the number of new positive cases of COVID-19 in Pulaski County. We appreciate your understanding as we navigate this unprecedented time. During all of these phases, the libraries' WiFi is on and available in our parking lots. - Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup> – Book drops open at all branches. Please return items at your convenience. We will not charge overdue fines until we reopen more fully.
- We are not accepting book donations at this time. Please do not place book donations in the book drops.
  
- Monday, May 18<sup>th</sup> (Richland Library – Tuesday, May 19<sup>th</sup>) – We plan to offer no-contact curbside pickup of requested items.
- We will also offer curbside pickup of black and white print jobs at no charge.
  
- Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup> (Richland Library – Tuesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>) – We plan to open the libraries to the public. We will follow any maximum occupancy and social distancing guidelines that are in place at that time.
- Overdue and printing fees will be reinstated at this time.

The library will have a Summer Reading Program this year, but it will be different than usual. Stay tuned for more details.

All in-person library programs and use of the community rooms by outside groups are cancelled until further notice.

The Statewide courier service, which allows PCLD patrons to check out books from across the state, is currently suspended. It will resume when most libraries across Missouri are open and able to participate.
